and only supersonic passenger aircraft.
Take-off, climb, cruise and land.

There are many flight simulators in the world
on which you may try your hand at flying an aircraft....
but only one Concorde Simulator....and it's here at Brooklands Museum!

We offer a number of special *At the Controls of Concorde* Silver Flights
which give you the Concorde Experience flight on Concorde G-BBDG,
and an hour on the Simulator with a British Airways' Concorde Captain
with 15 minutes at the controls flying under his instruction.
And at the end of your Simulator flying, the Captain will present you
with a signed certificate to commemorate the experience!

The Concorde Simulator first entered service in 1975 as one of just two in the world, and cost about £3million - £20 million at today's prices. One of the most sophisticated aircraft simulators ever created, it was installed at the British Aircraft Corporation at Filton, near Bristol and, for 28 years, was used to train all British Airways' Concorde aircrew.

When Concorde operations ceased at the end of 2003, BA decommissioned the simulator and, a year later, it was dismantled and transported to Brooklands Museum.

Now, as a result of a three-year-project funded by the Engineering and Physical Sciences Research Council (EPSRC), led by a team of volunteers from the Museum and the University of Surrey, along with the expert assistance of XPI Simulation, this unique piece of aviation technology is being flown again as a fixed-base unit - the only operational Concorde Simulator in the world.

You, along with three other 'trainee' Concorde pilots, will be welcomed on board the Concorde Simulator by the Concorde Captain and he will brief you on the Simulator and your time on it.

You will spend at least one hour on board, of which a minimum

of 15 minutes will be at the controls in the Captain's seat whilst he instructs you from the First Officer's seat and takes you through your paces. When others are flying you will be watching, learning and enjoying their experiences!

You might be flying from Heathrow over the City of London, from New York JFK and over Manhattan, or making that testing landing at Hong Kong's old Kai-Tak airport!

It might be daylight or night time.

Your emotions might range from trepidation to satisfaction, anxiety to excitement, and from failure to achievement.

Above all, it will be a thrill you will never forget.

Since our 'At the Controls of Concorde' programme began in August 2009, we have hosted

hundreds of people on the Simulator ranging from complete beginners to test pilots, and our Concorde Captains will tailor the experience to ensure that everyone has the maximum enjoyment.

1200 Welcome by Concorde Captain and Brooklands Concorde host in the Members' Bar in the Clubhouse
 1225 The Concorde Experience on Concorde G-BBDG.
 Afterwards the group will divide into two 'flights'. (Your final itinerary will advise which is your flight.)
RED FLIGHT
 1300 Proceed to the Concorde Simulator.
 1305 Simulator flying commences.
 1405 End of the Concorde Simulator flying. The Concorde Captain will present you with your Simulator Certificate. Visit to the flight deck of Concorde and short guided tour of the Museum.
 1535 (approx.) End of tour.
BLUE FLIGHT
 1300 Visit the Flight Deck of Concorde
 1310 Short guided tour of the Museum.
 1430 Proceed to the Concorde Simulator.
 1435 Simulator flying commences.
 1535 End of the Concorde Simulator flying. The Concorde Captain will present you with your Simulator Certificate.

FAMILY AND FRIENDS

Should family members or friends wish to travel to Brooklands Museum with the Concorde Simulator participant(s), please take careful note of the following:

- It will *not* be possible for family members or friends to access the Concorde Simulator.
- The Museum opens at 10.00am. It closes at 4.00pm from the last Sunday in October until the last Saturday in March inclusive. At all other times it closes at 5.00pm.
- Entrance to the Museum (included in the price for Simulator participants) is £9 per adult, £8 for Senior Citizens and £5.50 for children aged 5-16. Accompanying family or friends must pay this on arrival.
- The Concorde Experience (included in the price for Simulator participants) is £4 per adult and £2 for children 5-16. This should be booked on arrival.
