FLY THE CONCORDE SIMULATOR

Imagine yourself at the controls
of the world's most famous and only supersonic passenger aircraft.
being trained by a British Airways Concorde Pilot!
There are many flight simulators in the world
but only one Concorde Simulator....and it's here at Brooklands Museum!

The Concorde Simulator first entered service in 1975 as one of just two in the world,
and cost about £3 million - £20 million at today's prices.

One of the most sophisticated aircraft simulators ever created, it was installed at the British Aircraft Corporation at Filton, near Bristol and, for 28 years, was used to train all British Airways' Concorde aircrew.

When Concorde operations ceased at the end of 2003, BA decommissioned the simulator and, a year later, it was dismantled and transported to Brooklands Museum.

As a result of a three-year project funded by the Engineering and Physical Sciences Research Council (EPSRC), led by a team of volunteers from the Museum and the University of Surrey, along with the expert assistance of XPI Simulation, this unique piece of aviation technology is being flown again as a fixed-base unit - the only operational Concorde Simulator in the world.

SILVER FLIGHTS

You, along with three other 'trainee' Concorde pilots, will be welcomed by your Concorde Pilot in the Members' Bar of the Brooklands Clubhouse before enjoying the Concorde Experience on board our Concorde G-BBDG. There will also be a short 'History of Brooklands' tour of the Museum and an opportunity to visit the Flight Deck with your Pilot.

Once on board the Concorde Simulator, the Pilot will take you through pre-flight checks and explain the controls. Now it's over to you! You might be flying from Heathrow over the City of London, from New York JFK over Manhattan, or making that testing landing at Hong Kong's old Kai-Tak airport!

Your emotions might range from trepidation to satisfaction, anxiety to excitement, and from failure to achievement.

Above all, it will be a thrill you will never forget.

You will spend at least one hour on board, of which a minimum of 15 minutes will be at the controls in the Captain's seat. When others are flying you will be watching, learning and enjoying their experiences! (There will be three other participants on board)

GOLD FLIGHTS

The ultimate Concorde Simulator events! These include all the elements of the Silver Flight plus a Champagne Reception, lunch with the Concorde Pilot in our Ford Room, and a total of two hours on the Concorde Simulator with thirty minutes at the controls.

Since our 'At the Controls of Concorde' programme began in August 2009,
we have hosted hundreds of people on the Simulator from complete beginners to test pilots.
Our Concorde Pilots can tailor the experience to ensure that everyone has the maximum enjoyment.

 1535 (approx.) End of tour.

BOOKING CONDITIONS

1. Please call us to check availability for your chosen date. If this is available you have two options:
 - a) You may make immediate payment in full by credit or debit card. Please then return a signed Booking Form to us within 7 days.
 - b) You may make a provisional reservation. This will be held for you for three working days pending the receipt of your payment and the signed Booking Form.
2. On receipt of your Booking Form we will send you a Confirmation Invoice. (A final itinerary will be sent to you approximately seven days before your Simulator date).
3. In the event that you are forced to cancel your booking a cancellation charge may apply as follows:

Up to 8 weeks before your date	- No charge
4-8 weeks before your date	- 50%
Less than 4 weeks before your date	- 100%.
4. We reserve the right to cancel your simulator date due to insufficient bookings, technical failure, or other reasons beyond our control. In this case you will be offered an alternative date or a full refund.

RESTRICTIONS

1. All participants must be reasonably mobile and be able to take the captain's seat in the restricted confines of the Concorde flight deck. Certain disabilities may preclude participation in the Concorde Simulator. Please call us to discuss this if you have any concerns.
2. Persons under the age of 14 are not permitted. A maximum of two persons under 16 is permitted on the flight deck at any one time.
3. Should family members or friends of the Concorde Simulator participant(s) wish to travel to Brooklands Museum with them, you should take note of the following:
 - Due to the very limited space on the Concorde Simulator, it is not possible for family members or friends of participants to access the Simulator.
 - The Museum is opens at 10.00am. It closes at 5.00 pm from the last Sunday in March until the last Saturday in October, and at 4.00pm during the rest of the year. For Simulator events taking place outside these hours, family and friends will not have access to Museum areas.
 - Entrance to the Museum (included for Simulator participants) is £9 per adult, £7 for Senior Citizens and £5 for children aged 5-16.
 - The Concorde Experience (included for Simulator participants) is £4 per adult and £2 for children 5-16.
