Lunch or Dinner will be taken with Capt. Mike Bannister, British Airways' Chief Concorde Pilot,
and, after your meal, he will give a fascinating Concorde presentation.

Your day with Concorde will also include a brief visit to the Concorde Simulator
- the only one in the world open to the public!

If you flew Concorde in the past, we should be delighted to welcome you on board again.
If you never had the opportunity, now is the time to take your seat!

On your arrival at Brooklands Museum you will be invited to a Champagne Reception with Capt. Mike Bannister in the art deco Members' Bar in the Edwardian Clubhouse.

Our Concorde host will escort you to the check-in desk in the Concorde Terminal building to collect your boarding card before you board the aircraft.

The rear cabin is now a fascinating exhibition with four themes - the origins of Concorde; building and testing; Concorde in service; and tragedy, recovery and retirement. There are archive film clips, images, documents and artefacts from Concorde's history, and a film detailing the life of G-BBDG from construction to her restoration and opening to the public at Brooklands.

Walking forward you will see a display of passenger seating and memorabilia through the Concorde's commercial service from 1976 to 2003.

Moving in to the front cabin, it will be time for your 'flight'! Taking your place in one of the famous grey leather Concorde seats, you will be served a glass of champagne before 'take-off'.

On 'landing' you will be invited by Captain Bannister to the flight deck to sit in the pilot's seat next to him - time for a very special and memorable photograph!

Don't forget your camera!

On disembarkation, you will be able to see the Concorde Simulator on which all British Airways' pilots were trained.

Our Concorde Captain's Lunch or Dinner will take place in the Bluebird Room of the Clubhouse and Captain Bannister will give a Concorde talk and video presentation.

Finally, a Brooklands Concorde Certificate, signed by Captain Bannister, will be your permanent reminder of a very special day with this iconic aircraft.

CAPTAIN MIKE BANNISTER

Mike Bannister joined BOAC (British Airways' predecessor) in 1969 as a pilot and flight navigator on the Vickers VC10 fleet. He became the youngest pilot on the Concorde fleet in 1977 and was appointed as a Concorde pilot instructor in 1986.

He was promoted to the role of Chief Concorde Pilot in 1995 and, until the aircraft's retirement flew regularly as Captain on all of the aircraft's routes worldwide, both scheduled and chartered.

From July 2000 Mike was very actively involved in the corporate and industry efforts to achieve Concorde's safe return to service in November 2001. He liaised closely with manufacturers, Government and aviation authorities as well as representing British Airways in a range of arenas. Mike was seconded to the Air Accident Investigation Branch as Lead Technical Delegate during the Concorde Accident Investigation.

Following this, Mike delivered significant Concorde presentations at Heathrow and in New York for the top 50 Concorde customers.

He was at the controls of British Airways' Supersonic Flagship when she returned to service on November 7th 2001 and for the final scheduled flight from New York to London on October 24th 2003.

He flew Concorde to New York on her 21st birthday on January 21, 1997, and commanded Prime Minister Tony Blair's State Visit to Denver for the G7 Summit meeting later that year. He has worked

with NASA and Boeing on the next generation supersonic aircraft.

A particular highlight of Mike's Concorde career was commanding British Airways' Concorde G-BOAD as, to the cheers of more than a million spectators, she and the RAF's Red Arrows spearheaded the flypast at 1500 feet above The Mall and Buckingham Palace to mark Her Majesty The Queen's Golden Jubilee Celebrations on June 4th 2002.

Mike is a trustee of Brooklands Museum and a champion of the dreams, visions and pride that made Concorde such an icon of the 20th and 21st centuries.

CONCORDE CHAMPAGNE DAYS

BOOKING CONDITIONS

1. Please call us to check availability for your chosen date. If this is available you have two options:
 - a) You may make immediate payment in full by credit or debit card. Please then return a signed Booking Form to us within seven days.
 - b) You may make a provisional reservation. This will be held for you for three working days pending the receipt of your payment and the signed Booking Form.
2. On receipt of your Booking Form we will send you a Confirmation Invoice. (A final itinerary will be sent to you approximately seven days before your Champagne Day).
3. In the event that you are forced to cancel your booking a cancellation charge may apply as follows:

Up to 8 weeks before your date	- No charge
4-8 weeks before your date	- 50%
Less than 4 weeks before your date	- 100%.
4. We reserve the right to cancel your Concorde Champagne Day date due to insufficient bookings, technical failure, or other reasons beyond our control. In this case you will be offered an alternative date or a full refund.
5. In the event of Capt. Bannister being indisposed at short notice, his place will be taken by another senior British Airways Concorde Captain.

RESTRICTIONS

1. Certain disabilities may preclude the boarding of Concorde. Please call us to discuss this if you have any concerns.
2. A maximum of three persons under 16 accompanied by an adult is permitted.
