Curatorial Department	Collections Care Volunteer - Participates in the maintenance and cleaning of Brooklands exhibition areas, helping to preserve objects for the benefit and enjoyment of future generations	Monday - Friday
Curatorial Department	Heritage Engineer Project Team – Team members support existing team structures by assisting in the cleaning, maintenance and refinishing of aircraft and other exhibits located outdoors in the Aircraft Park.	Monday - Friday
Curatorial Department	Vehicle Cleaning Maintenance - responsible for keeping vehicles on open display clean and cared for. This team works with the Collections Care and Documentation Officer to make sure work is done on time and to museum standard.	Currently recruiting for Mondays only.
Curatorial Department	Oral History Volunteer - Meets and records interviews with people with personal memories of all aspects of Brooklands history including motoring, aviation, motorcycling and cycling	Flexible schedule - mutually acceptable times for interviewee and interviewer
Estates Department	Painting and Handyman Volunteer - helps to maintain and paint the Museum's site and buildings and monitors their condition, reporting any areas of concern	Various times in week but emphasis on building teams to work on Mondays and Tuesdays.
Events Department	Event Marshal - Interacts with the public to direct traffic and people on event days and acts as a general source of information for all event day visitors	Mostly weekends. Flexible nature depending on the number of events you choose to marshal.
Events Department	Event Registration Marshal - Interacts with the public, assisting the Events Team at the weekends, welcoming and registering participants and ensuring only those registered take part in events, demonstrations and cavalcades	Mostly weekends. Flexible nature depending on the number of events you choose to marshal
Events Department	Torch Light Tour Guides - conducts evening tours of the site focusing on hauntings, sightings of the paranormal and racing accidents	Between 1700 – 2100 from October 31 st and once or twice a month until February
Learning Department	Learning Volunteer (Corporate) - Welcomes corporate and adult groups to Brooklands and interprets the site and history through guided tours	Various times in week
Learning Department	Learning Volunteer (Schools and Families) - Welcomes school groups onto site and interprets the site and history through guided tours adapted to different age groups and learning styles	Monday - Friday
Learning Department	Historic Character for Schools - Welcomes schools and interprets the site and its history, providing story telling sessions dressed up as Brooklands historical character.	Various times in week
Learning Department	Family Storyteller - Welcomes families and interprets the site and its history for family groups by telling stories about the site and/or key historical figures	Various times in week
