A Trail for Children 3 to 8 years old and their helpers.



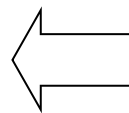
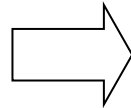
"Which vehicle is spelled the same backwards and forwards?"

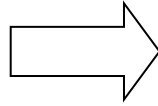


4. Can you find Bertie travelling at 207.9 mph on the 'Ultimate Bike?'
