A Trail for Children 3 to 8 years old and their helpers.



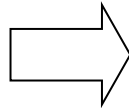
**"Which vehicle is spelled the same backwards and forwards?"**

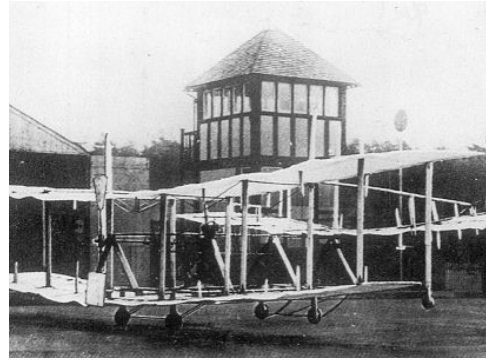
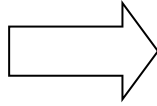
2. Now head to the Campbell Shed (Number 4 on the map). Can you find this car?

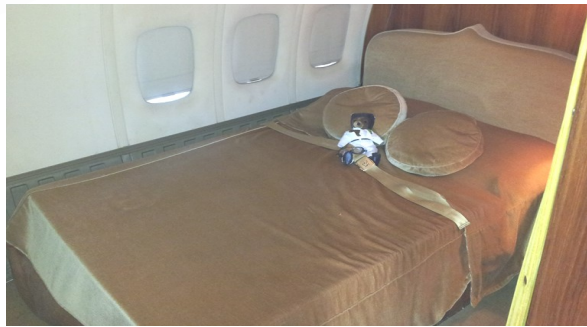


5. Head to the Avro Shed (Number 19 on the map). Can you spot Bertie on the first aircraft to be designed, built and flown in England?
