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Brooklands Museum's mission is 'to preserve and interpret the heritage of Brooklands, to use that heritage to inspire and educate and to provide a world-class visitor attraction accessible to all.' The birthplace of British motor sport and aviation, and home of Concorde, Brooklands comprises an unparalleled collection of Brooklands-related aircraft, racing cars and motorcycles all displayed in and around the historic buildings on the site where many were originally built or maintained. Brooklands is unique and opens every day with the support of an award-winning team of volunteers.

General Responsibilities:

As directed at pre-arranged times, to help maintain the Museum site - including surviving areas of the historic Brooklands Race Track - as tidy and clear of vegetation and litter as possible in order to slow the rate of decay, enhance its appearance and thereby help people understand and appreciate it. To maintain gardens in public areas and undertake light DIY. Also, to monitor the condition of the site and buildings and to report any areas of concern so that appropriate action can be considered.

Key Duties:

- Using brooms, rakes, shovels and gloved hands to clear detritus (vegetation and litter) from the Race Track
- Using hand tools to cut back and remove vegetation
- To undertake gardening in our public areas
- To carry out DIY tasks like painting

Essential Skills:

- Able to undertake light manual labour
- Work outdoors in various weather conditions

Desired Attributes:

- Enjoy working as part of a team.

Rewards:

- Induction, training and support.
- Opportunities to develop new skills and meet new people.
- The knowledge you are making a significant contribution to Brooklands Museum.
