

BTM Driving Group Track Day at Castle Combe (Cars)

Regulations and Entrant information

We have 48 places available for our BTM members and guests so please book early to avoid disappointment. The Entry Fee is £170 per BTM Entrant (£180 for non-members – space permitting) and this will give you up to 8 sessions throughout the day on the iconic Castle Combe Circuit (subject to weather conditions). Each session will be limited to a maximum of 12 vehicles on track at any one time.

BTM members will enjoy a discounted entry fee, but ALL entrants have the option of FREE loan helmet(s) for driver and passenger plus FREE tuition (subject to availability) as well as exclusive Paddock space and access to the Tavern for food and drinks throughout the day. It would help us with our planning if you could indicate on the entry form whether you will need loan helmet(s) and/or instruction. Please also indicate your Track Day experience level on the entry form i.e. Expert (lots of experience), Novice (some experience) or Beginner (No previous track day experience or this is your first track day at Castle Combe).

The Drivers briefing is mandatory for all entrants and you will only be allocated your driver's wristband at the conclusion of the briefing – **it is your responsibility to attend the briefing.**

Only **one passenger** at a time will be allowed in the front seat of any participating car. Passengers must be 17+ years old, have signed on and be wearing the appropriate wristband and helmet. There will be no additional charge for passengers.

Before being allowed on track each car will be checked by the marshal for its **noise test PASS** sticker, driver and passenger have the correct wristbands and that arms and legs are covered (i.e. no shorts or short sleeved tops) , are wearing Helmets and that seatbelts (where fitted) are secured.

Entrants will have to provide their own road going vehicles for this event. Vehicles do not need to be taxed or MoT'd but It is your responsibility to ensure your vehicle is in a "roadworthy" state and is able to cope with the extra stresses that track driving can put on a vehicles brakes, tyres, suspension and cooling system. Cars fitted with slick tyres are only permitted subject to strict driving conditions and must be agreed in advance of the event.

Pre-event Scrutineering will be carried out for basic safety requirements on all participating vehicles.

Helmets must be worn by all Drivers and Passengers – please bring your own helmet(s) if you have them.

Only Drivers who have signed on, paid the applicable entry fees and attended the drivers' briefing may drive on the track during this event.

Drivers should possess a **full UK or International Driving Licence** – this and the BTM membership card will be checked at signing on.

The event is for road going cars only and all must pass an RAC MSA noise test, **the Static limit is 100 dB(A)** measured at 45° from the exhaust outlet at 0.5 metres at 4,500 rpm. For cars without rev counters the Noise Marshal will use his experience and discretion, but his word is final!

Noise meters are also located around the circuit and these will be constantly monitored, any vehicle causing excessive noise will be black flagged and called into the pits for advice/rectification.

It is the driver's responsibility to ensure that the vehicle is within the noise limits. Failure to pass the static noise check will not result in a refund of your entry fee!

Should you decide that you wish to take out special Track Day insurance it is your responsibility to arrange it. Track Day insurance may be available through your existing insurer; alternatively check the web for specialist insurers. If you already have track day insurance through your car club then make sure it includes Castle Combe.

Spectators are welcome at this event; there are no minimum age restrictions or charge. Catering is also available onsite. Dogs (except Guide Dogs) are not allowed on site.

Final Instructions (including a Track day checklist) and a Disclaimer form will be sent out to entrants a week before the event.

We do hope you can join us for this Castle Combe Track-day. We have chosen it as it is a well-respected motor racing circuit, has excellent facilities and a club friendly reputation.
