Brooklands Museum is pleased to invite you to exhibit at this year's running of our Military Vehicle Day on Sunday 17th November. As before, the event is open to all ages, types and sizes of historic military vehicles, whether they be registered for road use or not. If you have something particularly big or heavy, or unusual that you wish to bring to the event, please contact us so we can discuss access and display arrangements. If you have something "interesting" that you would like to bring along that hasn't been seen here before then please let us know so we can add it into our pre-event marketing. A good quality image of your vehicle would also be useful to have, so we know what to expect on the day!

Besides enjoying the company of fellow enthusiasts and their vehicles, exhibitors will have full access to Brooklands Museum's 32-acre site and its exhibits. Don't forget to check out the Aircraft Factory and Flight Shed during the day for the military exhibits in them, including the Sopwith Camel, SE5a, Wellington Bomber, Hawker Hurricane and Hawker Hunter As in previous years, there will also be the opportunity for lighter vehicles to try out the challenging Mercedes-Benz World Off-Road Course at lunch time and add to the camouflage on the vehicles and yourselves with the mud from all the puddles you will be driving through! Our famous Test Hill will be run for ascents during the afternoon, subject to conditions on the day.

We will supply the owner of each pre-booked vehicle with a ticket that will admit the driver and one passenger to the event. If you are lucky enough to have a vehicle that will take more passengers, that wish to attend the day, you will be able to purchase extra tickets for them at the entrance on the day, or in advance from the Museum Shop (01932 857381 Ext 268), or on-line via the event page on our website at www.brooklandsmuseum.com

If you would like to join us for a very enjoyable day, please complete and return the entry form as soon as possible. Final details, tickets and passes will be sent out to you approximately 7 days before the event. A stamped addressed envelope sent back to us with your entry form would be very much appreciated.

There is a heightened level of security in the UK following terrorist related incidents in recent years and understandable sensitivities around people displaying and carrying weapons. Therefore, we have strict rules in place about the transportation, use and display of replica and/or deactivated weapons on our site and during events. No live weapons, ammunition or knives are allowed. If the vehicle you intend to display has deactivated/replica weapons permanently mounted in or on it as part of the vehicle, or the tows a larger artillery piece we are happy to grant access. Side arms or rifles/sub-machine guns may not be carried by individuals during the event. Living history or re-enactment groups wishing to use weapons including display rifles, pistols, bayonets or the like, as an integral part of their display must contact us in advance so that we can agree appropriate and safe arrangements. All weapons must be in compliance with current Regulations regarding replica firearms, de-activation certificates, appropriate methods of transportation and the like. **No weapons of any type may be fired on site unless specifically authorised by the Event Director on the day.**
