GO GOODWOOD - TOURING ASSEMBLY

The planned route will take us to Petworth where we have arranged a visit to Coultershaw Mill and then on to Goodwood House for a tour of the House followed by afternoon tea.

The run will be starting at The Pilots Hub at Redhill Airfield for signing on and bacon or sausage buttie, coffee or tea. Weather permitting, we will be parked up on the grass strip in front of the 1930's aviation-themed brasserie and coffee house. Assembly time at The Pilots Hub will be 9 a.m but this will be confirmed in the Joining Instructions to be sent out closer to the date.

There are a number of interesting pubs for lunch around Petworth or alternatively bring a picnic!

After lunch we will head off to Goodwood House for the tour of the House. Entry to the House is included in your fee together with afternoon tea. Again Marshalls will be there to assist with parking arrangements.

After tea you make your own way home.
