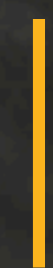

NAPIER ROOM 294 m<sup>2</sup> / 3165 ft<sup>2</sup>

Our flagship space and the jewel of our venue, the Napier Room, offers expansive views over the Paddock and lower Finishing Straight. With windows on two sides, it bathes in natural light (and also offers blackout curtains when this is not required).

This elegant period room accommodates up to 220 delegates and is ideal for conferences, exhibitions, product launches and gala dinners.

BLUEBIRD ROOM 117 m<sup>2</sup> / 1259 ft<sup>2</sup>

A bright, light and airy room with plenty of space. This room offers windows on three sides and a vaulted turn of the century ceiling. With its location, the room offers its own private access from the Motoring Village and inside it offers a walk through into our Members Bar area. The room also offers a walk through to the Napier Room making it an ideal choice for medium sized events or those looking for larger-scale possibilities.

# LOCKE KING ROOM 39 m<sup>2</sup> / 419 ft<sup>2</sup>

An amazing space at the front of the Clubhouse with views over the Paddock, Finishing Straight and Test Hill, the Locke King Room is flooded with daylight and has been stylishly refurbished with spot lighting. It is perfect for executive board meetings, private dining or cocktail receptions.

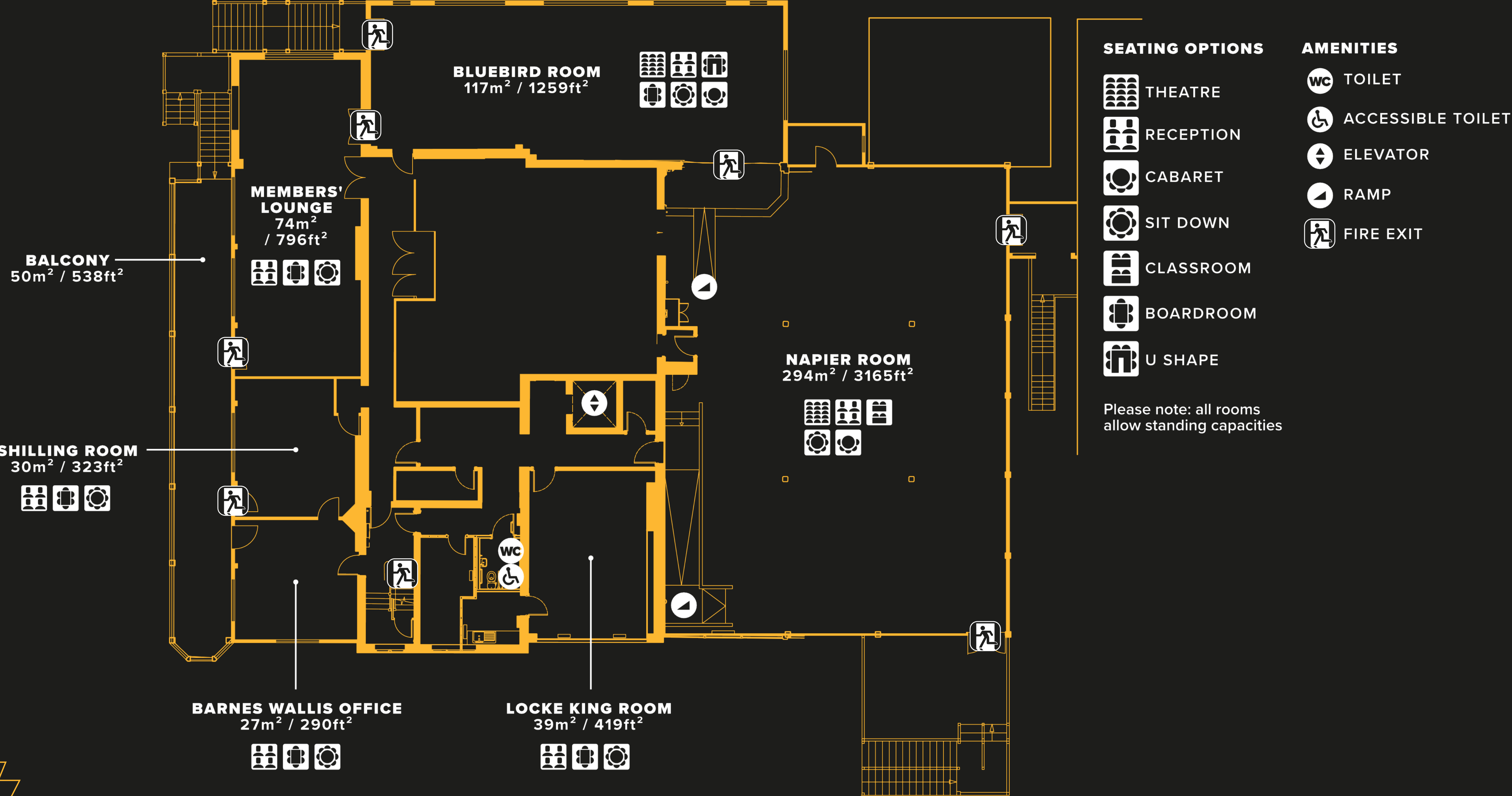

Brooklands Museum is located within the historic motor racing circuit between Weybridge and Byfleet and minutes from the A3, the M3 and the M25. It is ideally located 11 miles from Heathrow and 30 miles from Gatwick Airport.
